About the question whether there were sufficient numbers of reference books related to course available in the library, the rating was 74%. They rated 84%. The aspect whether the syllabus having ability to make your all round development. The rating was 74%. On the question whether the syllabus would be beneficial to build your career, the rating was 60%. On the question whether internal evolution completed within the time span, the rating was 84%. Whether the various tools / audio visual aids used while completing this syllabus, the rating was 72%.

The second part was concentrated on teacher's evaluation.
